

Overview of cognitive verbs in the Australian Curriculum v9.0

Technologies

This overview maps the common cognitive verbs used across the Australian Curriculum v9.0: Technologies. The cognitive verbs are categorised using Marzano and Kendall's (2007) four elements of the cognitive system: retrieval, comprehension, analysis and knowledge utilisation. When brackets are used, this indicates a cognition used in Technologies that aligns to a common cognition. For the full list of common cognitive verbs, refer to the Categories of common cognitive verbs at www.qcaa.qld.edu.au Note: Technologies have a learning area achievement standard from Prep to Year 8.
