Platform guide 24: Unlock a test attempt



During a test session, the **test administrator (TA)** may be required to unlock a test attempt.

A test attempt can become locked when a student logs into the NAP locked-down browser more than once to complete a test attempt, either on the same device or on a different device. For example:

- the student has experienced a technical issue
- a student who has been postponed is joining a new test session.

The appearance of the  icon on the TA dashboard indicates that a test attempt has been locked (the NAP locked-down browser will also display a message).

The TA must determine if it is appropriate to unlock and allow the student to access their test attempt.
