 - Analyse and synthesise at least two stimulus to identify different perspectives and the meaning suggested by these perspectives.
 - Identify the text type and language features of at least two stimulus.
 - Establish the purpose, audience, context and tone of at least two stimulus.
 - Refer to all of these points in your multimodal presentation.
- Present the multimodal presentation live. The multimodal presentation will be assessed via an online platform in the week beginning 7 October.
- The assessment will be recorded for quality assurance purposes.
- This section is worth 25 per cent of the marks for this subject. It is comprised of one question followed by a 7–8 minute conversation with the examiner.
